Gold Residential opportunity:

We are looking for three DofE Gold volunteers to help with our 5-day (4 night) summer residential camp 6th – 10th August. Food, activities and basic accommodation will be provided free of charge and we will require applicants to complete our standard volunteer application form, provide referees and have a DBS check.

Duties will include helping with snacks, meals and day-to-day camp life, also helping the riders with their riding and horse care. Ideally, we would like DofE candidates to have some equine experience.

Service opportunities:

We have an ongoing need for DofE volunteers to help with our term-time evening rides which we run Monday – Thursday starting at 6pm or 6:30pm. Some equine experience is required, and the role would include tacking up, leading a pony and side-walking.

We also offer our under-25 volunteers the opportunity to take part in the Young Equestrian Leaders Award (YELA) alongside their DofE service if they wish.
